## **Organization and Rules**



#### **Overview:**

Location: 1025 S Washington, Junction City KS (Parking lot of JC Naz Church)

Season: May – October

Schedule: Thursdays, 4:00 - 7:00 pm

## **General Vendor Rules and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Vendors must pre-register with the farmers market. Online registration is available at www.livewellgearycounty.org/farmers-market
- 2. Notify the market manager by Noon on market day if you won't be in attendance
- 3. Use hand sanitizer, gloves, and/or handwashing stations before and frequently during the market
- 4. All use of commercial tobacco is prohibited at the farmers market.
- All vendors must comply with KS Department of Agriculture Farmers Market Regulations and Food Safety Best Practices <u>MF3138 Foods Sold Direct to Consumers in Kansas: Regulations and Food Safety Best Practices (ksu.edu)</u> and Geary County Health Department public health directives
- 6. Any items that are not grown within the state of Kansas must be clearly labeled with their state of origin
- 7. At least 75% of items on a vendor's table must be grown, made, or have had value added to [homegrown, handmade, or homemade] unless you have prior approval of the Market Manager.
- 8. Vendors must remain at the market until closing time.
- 9. Communicate any questions, concerns, or constructive ideas to the Market Manager

# **Market Organization:**

- 1. The Geary Community Farmers Market is operated by Live Well Geary County, a registered 501c3 non-profit corporation.
- 2. The Market Manager is an independent contractor, hired by Live Well Geary County.
- 3. The Farmers Market Steering Committee represents vendors, Live Well Geary County, and other community partners to provide open communication and planning for the market.
- 4. At least 50% of products available at the market must be healthy foods.

## **Stall Set Up and Fees:**

- 1. Set-up begins at 2:30 pm each Thursday. Vendors should be set up no later than 3:30 pm
- 2. Booths must be within the space allowed and as directed by the Market Manager
- 3. Each vendor should maintain their sales area in a neat, clean, and orderly condition.
- 4. Each vendor is responsible for their own property and any damage or injury their property may cause at the market.
- 5. Each vendor must pay the applicable stall fees as follows:
  - a. Regular stall (not to exceed 10' wide): \$10 per week OR \$200 paid in full on or before the first market of the season
  - b. Large stall (any set-up exceeding 10' wide): \$15 per week OR \$300 paid in full on or before the first market of the season
- 6. Stall fees may be paid by cash or check (payable to *Live Well Geary County*)
